

### **Breaking the Silence**

On January 26, 2019, I heard the Lord say “Verbal Communication.” This is the year that we must pick up the phone and call those that are near and dear to us. In this day and age of technology, The Lord says that, YOU have replaced verbal communication with text messages, chat rooms and social media sites. No one truly knows how the other person feels because you mask your true emotions behind a text or chat with a simple response back “I’m good.” He said call one another to hear the smile on his/her face when they are happy or the frown when they are sad.

Ephesian 4: [29](#) Don’t use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them.

Romans 10:17 tells us that faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God. If words are not spoken you cannot hear. It’s through verbal communication that you hear the passion and emotion of the person. This is not a word against the use of technology, but a word of caution; do not overcompensate your family time together through use of text and social media outlets. These are tools, not your primary source of communication. On December 30, 2018, Apostle Leander Robinson shared the 2019 Theme: “It’s Time!!--To Focus On The Family!!” We must un-busy ourselves and spend more quality time together as a Body of Christ and as a Family. **FAMILY IS KEY AT CWCC!!!**

The Lord reminded me today of a vision that He showed me on last Sunday during preservice prayer. In the vision I saw many men in the church and they outnumbered the women GREATLY! The men were very protective and vigilant throughout the service as the women and children listened to the word of God go forth. There was a sense of peace, comfort and safety

in the sanctuary because of their presence. CWCC is a ministry for the FAMILY and the MEN. Many men will come to this ministry ready to serve and then there will be some that are injured and need to be ministered back to wholeness.

I was drawn to Prophetess Lois' powerful 2009 word, The Broken Rib. The scriptures used in her word were almost identical to the foundational scriptures of this year's theme (2009 prophetic word scripture: Genesis 1:26; 2:15-24) (2019 theme scriptures: Genesis 1:27; 2:18, 22-24). It always amazes me how the Lord connects these words back together. In the word, Prophetess gave a 3-Fold meaning of her dream she had, "Wives Concerning Husbands, Husbands Concerning Wives and the Body of Christ Concerning Each Other."

Her word says "...she puts the broken rib back in place and the family structure is as God designed it to be."

"Finally, understand that embracing the man and holding the broken rib is figurative or symbolic and not literal. Holding the rib speaks of support through TRUE LOVE **and prayer** for our husbands, through kindness **and prayer**, through encouragement **and prayer**, and through pain and suffering, **and more prayer**."

"It is important to remember that she must not let go, however long it takes; and he must not stop before getting the proper help he needs, or the painful process begins again. If she lets go, the pain may become too great for him to see his way clearly to proceed on the journey, which thereby jeopardizes both their lives; and if she holds on but he refuses to continue on, he may suffer unnecessary levels and length of pain which could then cause inflammation that may endanger other parts of the body, such as a heart of unforgiveness, an unbridled tongue, lips that speak untruth, and feet that are swift to cause confusion."

“Adam said that the woman is ‘flesh of my flesh and bone of my bone’. So if just one rib is broken, we must get in position and hold the ribs tightly for the sake of the one broken rib.

In the vision, it was clear to see that the injured man was going to have a difficult task driving in tremendous pain. But I was pleased to see that he did not refuse to **let me help** him and in so doing, he was able to--drive on, for the sake of all concerned.

**So wives**, will you help and patiently allow healing to come forth, however long it takes so your husband can--drive on?

**Husbands**, will you LET your wives hold your rib in place so you can--drive on? Your children are watching.

**Body of Christ**, will you allow each joint to perform its necessary function so the Body can “profit withal”? One can’t do it all. Your parts will wear out before time if you try to do too much, especially if that is not what God has assigned you to do. But, with each part working together, we can all grow to full maturity.”

According biblestudy.org “The **Number 19**. Nineteen, which is the combining of **10** and **9**, usually denotes God's perfect order in regard to his judgment.” God is doing the restructuring of the family and He is calling us back to intimacy with HIM and one another. In order for the wife to be able to hold her husband’s rib in place, she must be close to him, and the kids are close to them. The Lord is breaking the silent barriers in our homes this year in order for us to **LIVE, LAUGH, LOVE AND PRAY** for one another.
